# FAMILY BEHAVIOR THERAPY

at Family Services of NW PA

**Family Behavior Therapy (FBT) is an evidence-based program that helps treat substance abuse, conduct disorders, mood disorders, family dysfunction, and other problem behaviors. FBT treats parents/caregivers and adolescents struggling with substance abuse.**

The program aims to assist individuals and their families in maintaining long-term abstinence from substance abuse and encourage individuals to accomplish goals that are consistent with a drug-free, healthy, and prosperous life.

FBT addresses many family concerns, including:

- Behavioral problems
- Mood disorders
- Family dysfunction
- Poor communication
- Anger concerns
- Truancy
- Unemployment
- Home safety concerns

## What To Expect:

- Sessions take place weekly in the family's home 2-4 hours per week
- The average length of service for families enrolled in FBT is 6-12 months.
- Sessions are selected and implemented according to the needs of each family.

## Interventions Include:

- Program orientation
- Behavioral goals and rewards
- Intervention planning
- Communication skills
- Family reciprocity awareness
- Financial management
- Environmental control
- Child management skills

## Referral Process:

FBT is available to parents/caregivers and adolescents who are struggling with substance abuse and other behaviors related to substance abuse.
